

## Julie Chen Bio

Julie Chen is an internationally known book artist who has been publishing limited edition artists' books under the Flying Fish Press imprint for over 30 years. Her books combine text and image with innovative book structures to create reading experiences that engage the reader in interactions that go far beyond the simple turning of a page. Her work can be found in numerous collections worldwide including the Library of Congress, Washington, D.C., the Victoria and Albert Museum, London, and the Sir George Grey Special Collections, Auckland, NZ. In 2009 she was a featured artist in the PBS television series, *Craft in America* and in 2020 she was one of the featured artists in the documentary film, *The Book Makers*. She is a professor of Art at the University of Wisconsin, Madison in the Printmaking / Book Art / Papermaking area.
